About the Course

Registration Information:

Non-members! Register now for the course and your registration includes one-year membership in CPRS. Please use the registration form on the reverse side, making note of the registration fees for CPRS members and nonmembers. Because Institute registration is limited due to room size, registration closes when we meet capacity. A detailed package of information and the **study materials are mailed three weeks prior to the actual course dates**. Expect to study instructional material in detail prior to course instruction. Please do not wait to register for this course because space is limited. *We recommend not to make air travel arrangements until the minimum registration numbers have been met.*

On site registration is not accepted. The exam for certification is recommended only to individuals who have attended a prior CPSI course. Delegates who successfully pass the CPSI exam will be certified for three years. Renewal of certification may be achieved through a re-examination process only and all renewal questions are to be addressed to NRPA, 703/858-2149. To access updated exam [click here](#).

What to Know:

Advanced reading is required, prior to the course. This advanced reading is vital to the passing of the certification exam. The course is 15 hours of training from nationally known playground safety experts who prepare you to sit for the two hour Certified Playground Safety Inspector examination (100 questions) offered at the culmination of the certification course.

The CPSI practice exam can be purchased by candidates through logging into the NRPA Online Learning Center at www.nrpa.org/elearning. The questions follow the same format as the CPSI exam questions and all questions are based on the CPSI certification exam content areas.

California Playground Regulations:

Obtaining certification from CPSI will meet the State of California requirements regarding the inspection of playgrounds by a certified playground safety inspector.

English as Second Language (ESL)

English as second language (ESL) candidates may request a time extension and/or the use of a strict translation dictionary. Candidates request forms/fees must be submitted to NRPA no less than 30 days prior to the exam. The request form is available online, [click here](#).
